The *Saturdays for Success Program* (S4S) is sponsored by the Berkley African American Parent Network (BAAPN) in partnership with the Berkley School District. The purpose of S4S is to help all Berkley students have a successful K-12 academic experience by providing educational opportunities in literacy and math, and developing study skills that will ensure long term success.

We have added an Introduction to Lego Mindstorm Robotics session this year on a first come basis while spots are open for 4th-8th graders.

These goals are accomplished through the following S4S strategies:

- 1) Saturday tutoring - Elementary literacy and math, middle school and high school math and writing assistance. Classes are facilitated by Berkley teachers. **(Middle and High School students will need to bring their math homework with them to each class.** We will also offer writing/grammar support on assignments students bring in. Elementary students will rotate between interactive literacy and math centers with teachers and staff. It is optional for elementary students to bring their homework to class.)
- 2) National Honor Society High School students will be matched up with elementary students to assist with math drills/games and literacy activities.
- 3) Parental involvement - Parents have the opportunity to take a hands-on approach and assist their student with their academic development. (Please sign up to volunteer)

Schedule - Classes will be held on: October 14, 21, 28, November 4, 11, and 18 from 9:30-11 am at Berkley High School.

Fees - The cost of the program is \$20 per child (fee covers all sessions). If your family is eligible for free and/or reduced lunch benefits the cost is \$10 per child.

Behavior/Attendance Policy

Prompt and consistent attendance is expected for the duration of the program. Parents are responsible for all transportation to and from the school AND students are to be picked up by an adult in a timely manner upon dismissal from the class at 11 am. Failure to comply with this policy may result in dismissal from the program. The Berkley School District Student Code of Conduct is fully applicable during the S4S program.
